RESUSCITATION (CPR)



RESPONSE Check to see if Unresponsive/Unconscious

A casualty who is unresponsive

and not breathing normally needs urgent resuscitation



Adults & Children



AIRWAY Open airway, Head tilt/Chin Lift



BREATHING

Check breathing, if not breathing / abnormal breathing commence CPR



CPR

30 compressions : 2 breaths (if unwilling or unable to do breaths, consider doing chest compressions





Attach AED as soon as available and follow its prompts









Continue sequence until responsiveness or normal breathing returns, or help arrives
